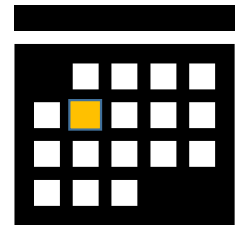

Mission

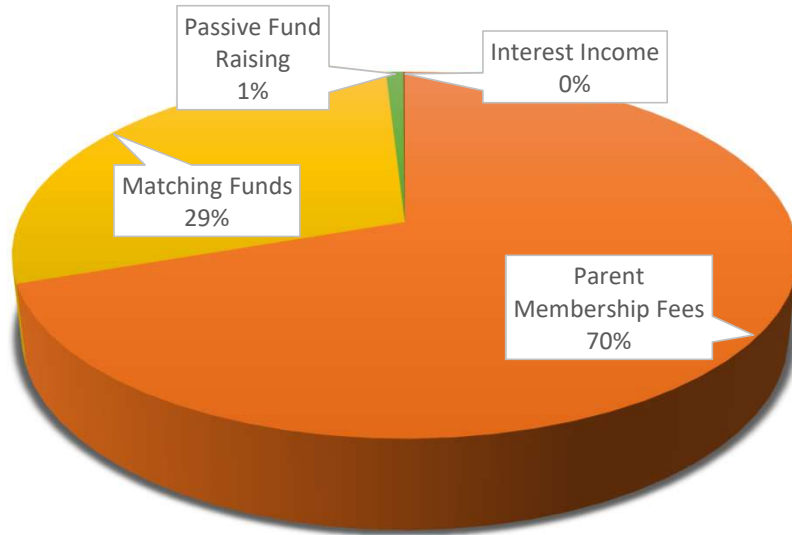

- We run a variety of programs on behalf of the school to enhance the curriculum

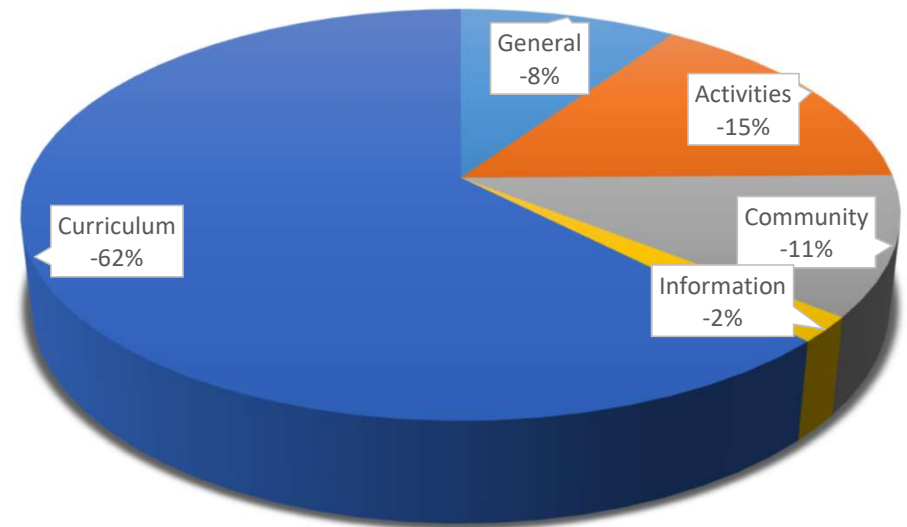
