	Mathematics	3 credits	Algebra 1 Honors, Geometry Honors, Advanced Algebra Honors, Math Analysis Honors
	Social Studies	3 credits	International Studies Honors 3-6 WA State History in IS 1 (7 th grade)
	World Language	2 credits (during high school)	Spanish 1-4, usually 3-4 in high school
	Occupational	1.0 credit	Example Options: Anatomy and Physiology, Graphic Production, Computer Science, Forensic Science, Law and Justice, Film Studies, etc.
	P.E.	1.5 credits	In 11 th or 12 th grade, students must pass a written fitness exam or submit a fitness plan to waive P.E. requirements. No <u>credits</u> will be earned by passing the exam or plan.
	Health	0.5 credit	9 th grade students will take a Health course. (Students who opted for Orchestra in 9 th grade will need to meet with their school counselor to make an alternative plan.)
	Electives	4+ credits	Any classes taken after your requirements are met will count as electives.
